As a regional communication facility, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) Regional Transportation Management Center manages traffic flow and emergency response via real time remote video cameras.

The facility required close coordination between the State, user groups and the designers due to the complicated and sensitive nature of the equipment and use. The center includes a communication theater for video monitoring, an emergency dispatch center, and emergency resource center and support facilities.

Interface designed several specialized systems, including the security and communication infrastructure.
