**T**hese historic structures are located in Crater Lake National Park and are listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

**The Lodge.** The project involved the remodel and restoration of 80 guest rooms, lighting fixtures, lobby, dining area, kitchen and great hall wing.

**Rim Village.** The upgrades in this historic building included the addition of a generator, which will provide continuous electrical service to year-round staff during the region's frequent winter power outages and a snow-melting system that will allow building access during the long winters at the park's 7,000-foot elevation.

**Superintendent's Residence.** Interface provided mechanical and electrical design services for this 3,350 SF residence. The design incorporates hydronics for snowmelt, an addition of a generator back-up system and HVAC upgrades.

Interface provided services for the electrical and lighting systems for the guest rooms and general areas of the lodge.
