Setting an excellent example in sustainable practices for the future generations they are instructing, the Estacada School District took a \$25 million education bond and put it to best use by considering the long-term effects of the design for their five schools:

- » Estacada High School / 140,000 sf remodel
- » Estacada Junior High School / 75,000 sf remodel
- » Clackamas River Elementary School / new 60,000 sf facility
- » River Mill Elementary School / 36,000 sf remodel with 14,000 sf addition
- » Eagle Creek Grade School / 36,000 sf remodel with 9,300 sf addition
- » Office Annex / 2,300 sf addition

The collective goal of the Estacada School District and its supporters was to have dependable, low-maintenance systems in their schools that they know will save money over the long-term. Putting such a goal into practice requires collaboration from the start so that the input from all interested parties results in success.
