Just off the highway on the way to Mount Hood sits the Good Shepherd Community Church. Having grown from a 500- to 2,700-congregation, the limiting factor of property boundaries forced a two-story design and a truly multipurpose auditorium that can seat 1,300. This hybrid concept of multipurpose use means that the auditorium serves as a sanctuary, gymnasium with maple sports floor, dining room, and hall for social functions, saving the church the cost of having to build an additional 12,000 sf of space to accommodate church and school activities.

The building that includes four offices, auditorium, choir room and meeting rooms. In addition, the expansion boasts the largest full industrial kitchen in East County, enabling the church to host such major events as Columbia Symphony concerts and graduation celebrations.



Permanent seating in the balcony areas reduces setup time for each event and improves lines of sight to larger assemblies.
