All working flawlessly” was the comment from Mark Fox, President of the White Oak Development Company, when discussing the HVAC, plumbing, electrical and lighting systems designed by Interface Engineering. The design criteria had a sustainable mix; built to stringent state guidelines, the electrical heat is an energy-efficient system. Based on the results of an energy recovery wheel analysis on the variable air volume mechanical units, it is expected to save energy over the long-term. The air handling system is computerized, presenting the only challenge when balancing the air flow.



The building serves 260 people and includes open and closed offices, conference rooms and support services, as well as a small cafe.
