This new four-story student dormitory can sleep 163 sophomores, juniors and seniors in multi-bedroom suites. The building also includes a central laundry, a community kitchen, student lounges and study areas.

Pacific University's residence hall is one of the first student housing projects on the West Coast to receive a LEED Gold Certification.

Interface provided engineering and design of heating and ventilation, plumbing systems including waste, vent, water, storm, and gas piping, electrical service and distribution, lighting design and controls and fire detection and alarm systems. Performance specifications were provided for the fire protection systems and building controls/building automation/energy management systems.
