Interface Engineering is currently providing consulting for Phase I of a new 610-bed student residence hall on the Sacramento State campus. The new facility will incorporate a variety of sustainable measures, including energy efficient lighting and cooling systems, water efficient fixtures, and low VOC products.

The residence hall is designed for a LEED Silver Certification.

Along with apartment suites, each floor will offer shared study areas and community lounges. The facility will provide a mail room, laundry areas, a conference area, tutoring space and retail areas as well as a police substation.
